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The 5.09 HSED option is an individualized, self-paced program for adults that have not found success due to any kind of learning disability or low TABE assessment score that causes barriers to passing all of the GED tests.

### 5.09 HSED PROGRAM COMPONENTS

- Paperless, project-based curriculum infused with Native American values
- Projects and instructions come complete on a flash drive
- Students complete the following core competencies with at least 75% accuracy
  - Language Arts (Writing)—12
  - Science—41
  - Language Arts (Reading) —9
  - Math—60
  - Language Arts (Language) —6
  - Technology—17
  - Social Studies (History) —46
  - Health—17
  - Social Studies (Civics) —32
  - Employability—10
- Some assignments can be completed quickly and others may take some time. Don't be discouraged!
- Assignments and projects are submitted via e-mail to your instructor.
